CPR

Are you prepared to help in a real and very common crisis—one that could happen at any time? Do you know how to correctly perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)?

Heart disease is the No. 1 cause of death in the United States. A heart attack occurs when blood supply to a part of the heart is blocked. More than 800,000 people had a heart attack last year alone. Many heart attack victims develop symptoms outside of a hospital environment, making it important to recognize symptoms of a heart attack and be prepared to respond. A heart attack is one of the most common causes of cardiac arrest. Performing CPR and using an automated external defibrillator (AED) as soon as possible greatly increases the chance of someone surviving cardiac arrest. Everyone should learn these lifesaving techniques.




